- I got multiple awards including JACQUES JOSEPH Medal and from EAAPS and the Efrain Davalos Award from AAFPRS.
- I am serving as editorial board member of 1) Facial plastic Surgery and Aesthetic Medicine, 2) Facial Plastic Surgery, 3) Auris Nasus Larynx.
- I was the Past president of Korean Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery and serving as the current President of Pan-Asian Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery.
- I have published 2 rhinoplasty textbook and contributed book chapter at more than 8 internationally acclaimed facial plastic surgery textbooks.
- I published over 74 papers on rhinoplasty in peer reviewed international journals. Most recent papers include 1) Mono-Unit Alar Rim Graft Technique for Tip-Alar Margin Support. Aesthet Surg J. 2020, 2) Na HG\_Jang YJ. Use of Nasal Implants and Dorsal Modification When Treating the East Asian Nose. Otolaryngol Clin North Am. 2020.
- I had been invited more than 150 international events hosted in 25 different countries to teach rhinoplasty.

Prof Dr Fazil Apaydin is working as a professor at the Department of Otorhinolaryngology of Ege University in Izmir, Turkey. His subspecialty is facial plastic surgery and he is the head of Division of facial plastic surgery since 1999. He passed the board exam of the International Federation of Facial Plastic Surgery Societies in 2007 to become a European board certified in facial plastic surgery. He is the immediate past president of the European Academy of Facial Plastic Surgery which is the biggest society on facial plastic surgery in Europe since 1977. He is the UEMS representative of the academy in the UEMS-ENT committee. He is the executive board member of the Turkish Society of Facial Plastic Surgery. He is the executive board member of the International Board Certification and European Board Certification of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery. He has been lecturing, teaching and operating on facial plastic surgery procedures within the last 20 years all over the world. He has lectured and operated extensively in the Middle East and Gulf countries as well. He has written numerous articles and book chapters on facial plastic surgery.

Prof. Hellings is Clinic Head and Full Professor at the University Hospital of Leuven (Belgium), and Professor at the Universities of Amsterdam (The Netherlands) and Guest professor at the University of Ghent (Belgium). His main clinical and research interests belong to the wide field of rhinology and immunology where he has published more than 300 manuscripts in high-standard scientific journals, including Nature, Lancet and others.

Peter Hellings was Secretary-General of the European Academy of Allergy and Clinical Immunology from 2015-2019, and founder and current chair of the European Forum for Research and Education in Allergy and Airways disease (EUFORA), aiming at the implementation of optimal care for respiratory allergies and chronic respiratory conditions.

### EFFICACY OF AVAILABLE TREATMENT OPTIONS FOR AR

Claus Bachert MD PhD is chief of clinic and professor at the University Hospital of Ghent, Belgium, and also holds positions as professor at the Karolinska Institute, Stockholm, Sweden and at the First Affiliated Hospital, Sun Yat-Sen University, Guangzhou, China. He qualified from the University of Heidelberg, Germany, and trained in ENT-diseases and allergology in Mannheim and Düsseldorf. His research interests include the pathophysiology and management of diseases of the nose and sinuses such as allergic and non-allergic rhinitis, chronic rhinosinusitis and nasal polyposis. Specifically, he has worked on endotyping rhinosinusitis, innovative treatments such as biologicals for recalcitrant disease, and the role of Staphylococcus aureus in the inflammation of nasal polyp disease. Dr. Bachert chairs the Upper Airways Research Laboratory at Ghent University, and has published over 600 peer-reviewed articles in international journals. Dr. Bachert received several national and international prizes, and two doctor honoris causa (Capital University Beijing, China, and Democritus University, Trace, Greece).

Dr. Bachert forms part of the international guidelines ARIA (Allergic Rhinitis and its Impact on Asthma) and EPOS (European Position Paper on Sinusitis and Nasal Polyposis), currently serves in the Board of EUFORA, and served in the boards of EAACI and WAQ, was President of the German Allergy Society (DGAKI, 2007-2010) and Vice-President 2011-2016. He currently serves as Editor for the Journal of Allergy and Clinical Immunology.
